### About the Michael C. Carlos Museum

The collections of the Michael C. Carlos Museum of Emory University span the globe and the centuries. Housed in a distinguished building by renowned architect Michael Graves, the Carlos maintains the largest collection of ancient art in the Southeast with objects from ancient Egypt, Greece, Rome, the Near East, and the ancient Americas. The Museum is also home to collections of nineteenth- and twentieth-century sub-Saharan African art and European and American works on paper from the Renaissance to the present day.

The Carlos Museum works with Emory faculty members to develop unique special exhibitions that draw on collections from around the world to engage the public and contribute to current scholarship. The Museum also mounts exciting traveling exhibitions developed by other institutions and makes them available to its community.

Included in the museum's permanent collection are Ancient Egyptian and Nubian Art, Ancient Near Eastern Art, Art of the Ancient Americas, Early Asian Art, Greek and Roman pieces, and Sub-Saharan African works. The current Special Exhibition at the Carlos museum is features Maps and Monuments of Ancient Rome. Upcoming Special Exhibitions are titled: *Domains of Wonder: Selected Masterworks of Indian Painting* and *Cradle of Christianity: Jewish and Christian Treasures from the Holy Land*.

### **Directions to Indian Hills Country Club**

#### **DIRECTIONS FROM 285**

Going west on I-285, exit at Riverside Drive, turn right. Follow Riverside Drive to Johnson Ferry Road, turn left onto Johnson Ferry Road and follow it to Lower Roswell Road. Turn left onto Lower Roswell Road and follow it to the third traffic light. At the intersection of Lower Roswell Road and Indian Hills Parkway, turn right at the light. (Sign reads IHCC Estates.) Make the first immediate left onto Clubland Drive. We are located about  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile on the right-hand side.

#### **DIRECTIONS FROM GA 400 GOING TOWARDS 285**

Follow GA 400 to the Sandy Springs exit. Turn right onto Abernathy Road. Follow Abernathy to Johnson Ferry Road and turn right onto Johnson Ferry Road. Follow Johnson Ferry Road to Lower Roswell Road and turn left. Follow Lower Roswell Road to the third traffic light and turn right onto Indian Hills Parkway. (Sign reads IHCC Estates.) Make the first immediate left onto Clubland Drive. We are located about  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile on the right-hand side.

### DIRECTIONS COMING NORTH ON 75

Take the Delk Road exit off 75 North and turn right. Delk runs into Terrill Mill Road. Follow Terrill Mill Road over to Lower Roswell Road (bear to the right). Take Lower Roswell Road straight until you reach the intersection of Indian Hills Parkway. (Sign reads IHCC Estates.) Turn left onto Indian Hills Parkway and take the first immediate left onto Clubland Drive. We are located about 3/4 mile on the right hand side.
